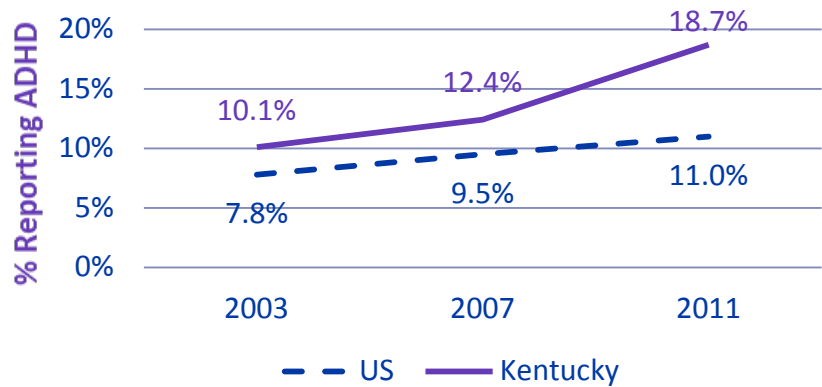


# State Profile: Kentucky

## Parent-Reported Diagnosis of ADHD by a Health Care Provider and Medication Treatment Among Children 4-17 Years: National Survey of Children's Health\* – 2003 to 2011

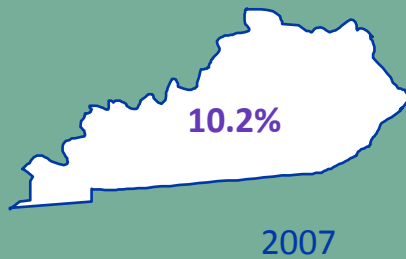
### Survey Question

Has a doctor or health care provider **ever** told you that your child had attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder or attention deficit disorder (**ADHD or ADD**)?



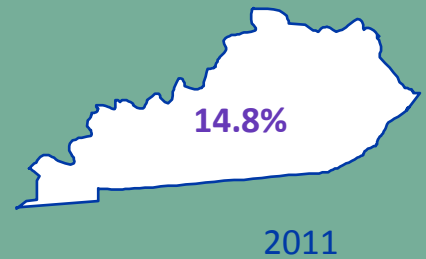
Does your child **currently** have ADHD or ADD?

In 2007, 7.2% of US children and 10.2% of children in Kentucky had **current** ADHD, by parent report.



Among all US states, Kentucky ranked 6<sup>th</sup> highest.

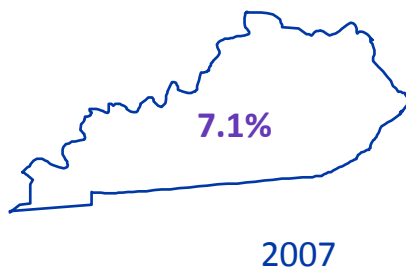
In 2011, 8.8% of US children and 14.8% of children in Kentucky had **current** ADHD, by parent report.



Among all US states, Kentucky ranked 1<sup>st</sup> highest.

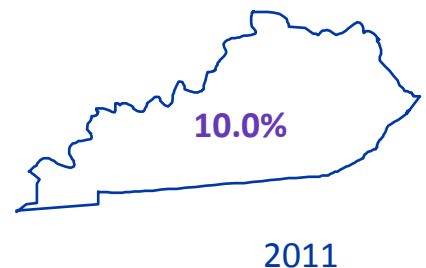
Is your child **currently** taking medication for ADHD or ADD?

In 2007, 4.8% of US children and 7.1% of children in Kentucky were taking medication for ADHD.



Among all US states, Kentucky ranked 7<sup>th</sup> highest.

In 2011, 6.1% of US children and 10.0% of children in Kentucky were taking medication for ADHD.



Among all US states, Kentucky ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> highest.
