### **Tutoring Sessions Typically:**

- Last 60 minutes
- Focus on one or two educational issues.

### **At LDA you can...**

- Develop a positive attitude toward math & reading.

- Follow the explanations in class and ask questions.
- Improve your listening and note-taking skills.
- Work out homework problems on time.

The sessions cover study skills, test-taking strategies, and use of resources. Tutoring services are available at a reduced rate or free of charge to many students that are in the Free or Reduced Lunch program. You are encouraged to visit our Tutoring Center early in the semester to reserve your spot and appointment time(s).

### **What is the tutor's role?**

A tutor's role is to help students understand concepts, not to repeat information available from their teachers or textbooks. To accomplish this, tutors may engage in discussions of their topics so that students can develop their own ideas.

### **What should I expect?**

LDA understands that families ask for tutoring help for a variety of reasons and assigns tutors with that in mind.

We work with students who:

- Have a learning disability and need extra attention.
- Do not understand the subject matter and/or do not have an aptitude for a specific subject.
- Need help getting organized and staying on track.
- Simply work better guided patiently one-on-one.

Matching the right tutor with your child is of great importance to us. We'll spend the necessary time on the phone, or in person to:

- Discuss your child's needs.
- Learn from you about your child's strengths, habits, fears and interests.
- Discuss what works and what doesn't.
- Brainstorm to form a plan of action.

We work hard to attract, support and keep the best educators. We only have tutors who meet a high standard of knowledge and empathy. Our tutors are certified professional teachers. Our ultimate goal is for you to be able to trust the educator that teaches your child. You can expect your tutor to be an honest, reliable, knowledgeable person who is competent and works well with your child.
